



Elective Course Delivered through a dedicated career exploration class	Schools with flexible electives	Depth of engagement, consistency
After-School Program Offered as clubs or enrichment sessions	Schools with strong enrichment culture	Flexible, partner access
Integrated Curriculum Embedded into core/elective subjects	Schools without electives	Contextual, relevant
Pull-Out/Workshop Students attend career sessions during school	Limited staffing or scheduling	Scalable, focused
Grade-Level Advisory Career topics during advisory or homeroom	Regular advisory or homeroom schedules	Supports ECAPs, schoolwide consistency
Summer Camp/Intersession Short-term intensive programming focused on exploration and skill-building	Schools with summer/intersession opportunities	High impact, hands-on, ideal for external partnerships
